Wouldn't it be great to provide your students with an exciting, fun-filled learning experience next school year? Heading into its 22nd year, the **Wood Magic Forest Fair** is a free, fun, forestry-fact-filled field trip and festival for fifth-graders. A four-hour program of forestry-related educational experiences and demonstrations, the fair combines hands-on activities with visually engaging presentations to teach children about the importance of forest lands to wildlife, the economy and our daily quality of life.

Students Have Fun While Learning

The fair isn't just a walk in the woods; it's a learning experience. South Carolina's **Wood Magic Forest Fair** is a comprehensive environmental education program correlated to state curriculum standards in science and language arts. More than 38,000 students from every corner of the state have participated in the program since its inception in 1999, the overwhelming majority of whom demonstrate a significant gain in knowledge about forests, forest products, conservation, and the environmental, social and economic benefits of forests.

- **Harbison State Forest, Columbia**—Oct. 25-29, 2021

Dear fifth-grade teacher:

Wouldn't it be great to provide your students with an exciting, fun-filled learning experience next year? That is what more than 1,800 fifth-grade students experienced in 2019 at South Carolina's Wood Magic Forest Fair. As Herbert Jenkins from Andrews Elementary, who participated, said, "The program was fun, informational, and fast-paced. The students were involved, and they learned a lot. The assessment data shows that they understood what was happening."

During this four-hour, **SCDE standards-correlated program**, your class will learn the many benefits of the forests in our state, learn how wood is turned into many different products, learn how foresters use fire to help the forest and wildlife, make recycled paper, and experience a magic show about wood products. Teachers will receive many classroom activities and supplies to supplement your curriculum, and students receive a bag full of "goodies" that relate to forestry, including a Wood Magic T-shirt. All teachers, chaperones and students will receive a pizza lunch and snack. All for FREE!

The Wood Magic Forest Fair has been so successful that applications have exceeded available slots every year, so don't delay sending in your application. Wood Magic will be held at these locations in the 2021-2022 school year:

- **Piedmont Forestry Center**, (Tamassee)—October 5-8, 2021
- **Harbison State Forest**, (Columbia)—October 25-29, 2021
- **Sewee Environmental Education Center**, (Awendaw)—November 16-19, 2021

Please consider the following before returning your application:

1. We would like for you to coordinate with the other fifth-grade teachers at your school and select a lead teacher. This person will be our primary contact for the application process. Also, we do not need to know the exact number of students at this point, just give us an estimate of the total number of classes expected to attend from your school and the average class size.
2. Please check the school calendar for next year to make sure there are no conflicts with in-service days or holidays before selecting a day. We will try our best to accommodate your selection, but due to the number of applications we receive this is not always the case. Please make note if certain days are not acceptable.
3. Be sure that your planning is such that you arrive no later than 15 minutes before your scheduled start time. Because the Wood Magic is a tightly scheduled event and lasts approximately 4 hours, you may not be able to arrive back at school by the regular dismissal time. Please plan for this and clear this with your principal before you apply. ***If you cannot arrive on time and stay for the entire event, we respectfully request that you do not apply.***
4. Both the students and teachers receive educational materials, t-shirts, lunch and snacks by attending Wood Magic. It is fun and exciting! However, it is an educational event, with the teachers having the responsibility of administering a pre-test and post-test assessment, and conducting activities to prepare the students for the fair. The grants that we receive to conduct this event require the cooperation of the teachers, principals, and staff to make it successful. These grants are what allow us to offer this program **FREE OF CHARGE** to South Carolina's fifth-grade students.
5. We will be following the latest guidance and safety protocols from the CDC and SCDHEC to do our best to protect everybody from the risk of spread of COVID-19. More information and safety procedures will be provided to teachers at the beginning of the 2021-2022 school year.

If you and your class would like to attend the Wood Magic Forest Fair, we guarantee that you will enjoy an exciting and fun-filled day learning about South Carolina's natural resources and the importance of forests in our daily lives.
